Entry Requirement Policy and Procedure

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1. POLICY

ANIT Australia Pty Ltd T/A Albright Institute of Business and Language will ensure that all individuals who enter ELICOS Courses and Nationally Accredited Programs have the appropriate skills and abilities they require to be successful in their studies

2. PURPOSE

This policy outlines a documented procedure for assessing prospective students' qualifications, experience and English language proficiency.

The policy provides guidelines to the staff to make an informed decision prior to offering course(s) to the student intending to undertake study at Albright Institute.

3. SCOPE

This policy applies to all the prospective and current international students of Albright Institute.

4. POLICY

4.3 Exceptions to Evidence of English Language

1.An applicant who is a citizen of, and holds a valid passport issued by the United Kingdom, the United States of America, Canada, New Zealand, or the Republic of Ireland;

2.In the two years before applying for visa, an applicant has successfully completed the requirements for a Senior Secondary Certificate of Education, in a course that was conducted in Australia in English.

3.An applicant who has successfully completed a minimum of 5 years of study in English undertaken in one or more of the following countries: Australia, Canada, New Zealand, South Africa, the Republic of Ireland, the United Kingdom, or the United States of America.

4. However, all the students irrespective of the above categories and are applying for VET courses, will be required to take the Albright LLN test before the commencement of the course.

4.4 Language, Literacy and Numeracy Requirement for VET Courses

1.LLN test is a MANDATORY requirement at Albright Institute.

2.LLN test is to be administered to EVERY VET STUDENTS who is enrolling for a Vocational Qualification at Albright Institute.

3.LLN test will be used for determining student's Language, Literacy and Numeracy skills.

4.The LLN Test has to be fully attempted by each VET student. If the student misses any part/skills assessment, then he/she will be asked to undertake this again.

5.If the student is enrolling for a packaged program, then the first AQF level qualification LLN Test should be administered to the student.

6.This requirement enables AIBL to identify if the student needs any LLN support to successfully complete dying the selected VET course at Albright.

7.The LLN Test can be taken prior to the Orientation Day or will have to be taken on Orientation Day.



4.5 Scenarios for further understanding of entry requirement for English Language proficiency:

Scenario	Applicant	Action to be taken	Reasoning
Scenario No.1	If a student has successfully completed a VET qualification at Albright Institute before.	The student will be required to take the LLN Test for the level of qualification that he/ she is enrolling now for at Albright Institute.	This is because – previously we did not have LLN test mapped to the AQF level of qualification. Hence the student will be asked to undertake the LLN test.
Scenario No.2	If student meets the English Language entry requirement as mentioned respectively in the qualification OR has submitted English document (IELTS/PTE etc.) which is expired for more than two years old.	1.LLN Test will be sent to the student. 2.LOO and COE need not have any conditions.	1.After assessment of LLN test, if "LLN Support is not required", then the student begins the VET Course. 2.If the student "Requires LLN Support", then the student will commence the course and will be provided LLN support.
Scenario No.3	In case where there is No proof of English (IELTS/PTE/GE etc.) submitted or the result in the English Document is lower than the minimum English language requirement for the qualification. 5.PROCEDURE

The student selection process at Albright Institute is conducted in an ethical and responsible manner. Entry requirements are in accordance with equal opportunity regulations in Australia.

1.The applicant is required to complete and sign the AIBL Application Form;

2.The applicant is required to attach all relevant certified academic transcripts in line with the Entry Requirements;

3.The applicant is required to provide Proof of English proficiency of an IELTS score of 5.5 or equivalent (as mentioned in the entry requirements respectively for each course);

4.Documents in a language other than English must be translated to English by a NAATI approved translator only.

5.Successful applicants would receive a full or conditional Letter of Offer and a Student Acceptance Agreement.

6.Applicants are required to sign the Student Acceptance Agreement and make the initial tuition fee deposit as indicated in the Student Acceptance Agreement.

7.If the applicant is claiming Credit Transfer – Original Statement of Attainment or Original Qualification certificate has to be cited and verified by the Admissions officer.

8.While issuing a CoE, if the PRISMS prompts for complying with Standard 7 off NCP 2018 regarding transfer of student, the student should be able to advice on that.

9.The student will take the Albright LLN Test prior to the course commencement on the day of the Orientation.

10.The student will be required to apply for Unique Student Identifier (USI) if he/she does not have one.


